
Greetings of love and peace!

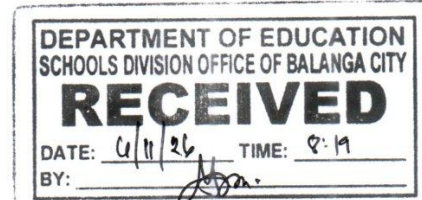
