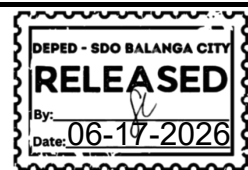

CID UPDATING ACTIVITY AND ACTION PLANNING ON RAPID MATHEMATICS ASSESSMENT, LITERACY AND NUMERACY ASSESSMENT AND OTHER REQUIRED ASSESSMENTS FOR SY 2026-2027

To: Division Chiefs
Education Program Supervisors
All Others Concerned

1. The EOSY Results for SY 2025-2026 in the National Assessment using RMA and LNA showed that a significant number of learners in Math need interventions in order to be grade level ready. As reflected in the CO EOSY dashboard, only 43.28% of learners are grade level ready in Key Stage 1; 22.26% in Key Stage 2; 1.61% in Key Stage 3 and 9.37% in Key Stage 4.
2. The CID Updating Activity and Action Planning on Rapid Mathematics Assessment, Literacy and Numeracy Assessment and Other Required Assessments for SY 2026-2027 will be held on June 26-27, 2026 at a venue to be announced. The activity aims to:
 - identify schools which need close monitoring and supervision in terms of Math and Reading instructions as found in the Technical Assistance Plan;
 - intensify the monitoring of the school intervention activities particularly in Literacy and Numeracy and other school- initiated intervention approaches;
 - administer unified formative assessments on a regular basis,
 - come up with strategies which will motivate schools in improving learning outcomes in Math;
 - monitor RO and CO downloaded assessments;
 - devise means to capture necessary data as a result of monitoring and evaluation;
 - interface with the LRMDS team to support the delivery of Math instructions; and
 - next steps planning.
3. Participants to the activity are the Chief Educ. Supervisor, Education Program Supervisors, Project Development Officer, Division Librarian, and Administrative Staffs.
4. Herewith is the matrix of activity (See Encl. 1).

5. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged to PSF RO-III-2026-05-0975 subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Since the activity falls on a Saturday, participants are entitled to leave credits as stipulated in D.O. No. 13, s. 2024.
