



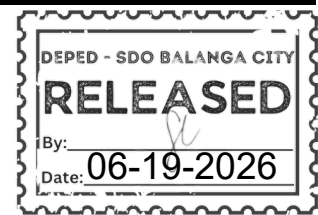

**ONLINE TRAINING ON THE STRENGTHENED SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SSHS)
CURRICULUM FOR TEACHERS**

To: Division Chiefs
Private and Public Senior High School Heads
Private and Public Senior High School Teachers
All Others Concerned

1. In reference to Memorandum DM-OULS-2026-229 titled “Online Training on the Strengthened Senior High School (SSHS) Curriculum for Teachers,” this Office announces the launch of the online training program through the DepEd Learning Management System (LMS).
2. This initiative aims to ensure that all Senior High School (SHS) teachers are equipped with the necessary content knowledge, pedagogical strategies, and curriculum standards required for the effective implementation of the SSHS Curriculum.
3. The training is intended for all SHS teachers handling Core Subjects, Academic Electives, and Technical Professional (TechPro) Electives in both public and private schools. Instructional leaders, such as Principals, Head Teachers, and Master Teachers, are also enjoined to access the materials to provide technical assistance to their teachers.
4. The training consists of self-paced courses organized into three groups: Core Subjects, Academic Electives, and TechPro Electives. Each course includes modules focused on:
 - Curriculum Overview, Standards, and Content.
 - Unpacking the Competencies.
 - Selection of Teaching Strategies and Assessment of Learning.
5. To access the training, participants must go to learning.deped.gov.ph and sign in using their DepEd Microsoft email account. Private school teachers must first request access through the designated registration links provided in the national memorandum.
6. Upon successful completion of all required components including pre-tests, activities, post-tests, and evaluation forms, participants will receive a Certificate of Participation. Additionally, all teachers must complete a Workplace Application Plan (WAP) outlining how they will apply their learning in their specific school or classroom context.

7. The courses will remain accessible throughout school year 2026-2027, allowing participants to enroll in and complete more than one course as needed.
