

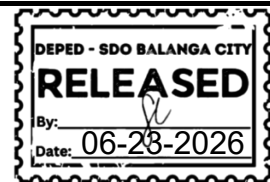

CONDUCT OF PHILIPPINE FLAG DISPOSAL CEREMONY

To: Chiefs, CID and SGOD
Education Program Supervisors
Public and Private School Heads
Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. **In accordance with Republic Act No. 8491**, also known as the *Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines*, particularly Section 14 which mandates the proper and respectful disposal of worn-out or damaged Philippine flags through solemn burning, this Schools Division Office of City of Balanga announces the conduct of a **Flag Disposal Ceremony**.
2. This ceremony seeks to uphold the proper observance of Republic Act No. 8491 and to foster a deep sense of patriotism and reverence for the national symbol. It shall be conducted in a solemn manner, highlighting the dignified folding of the worn-out flag, its ceremonial burning, and the respectful burial of its ashes, in strict accordance with established protocols
3. The ceremony will be held on June 25, 2026, 3:00 PM at COBNHS (JHS) Covered Court.
4. Both BSP and GSP leaders are invited to witness and participate in the said ceremony. Likewise, schools may send their scouts subject to available means and are advised to wear the **Type A Scouts Uniform** during the activity.
5. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
